We are seeking an experienced **Lifting Equipment Inspector** to take on a supervisory position within our Inspection Team, based at our Stevenage facility. - Contribute to the continuous improvement of inspection procedures and documentation systems.
- Liaise with Warehouse Manager and other departments to coordinate equipment availability and maintenance schedules.
- Support external inspections and audits as required.
